Recognition of Participation in the COVID-19 Universal Community Testing Programme as Continuing Professional Development Activity

Registrants are invited to note that the Radiographers Board has recognised participation in the COVID-19 Universal Community Testing Programme ("UCTP") as Continuing Professional Development ("CPD") Activity.

To identify as early as possible asymptomatic COVID-19 patients in the community and achieve the target of early identification, early isolation and early treatment to cut the community transmission chain, the Government has launched the COVID-19 UCTP on 1 September 2020 for all Hong Kong residents. collected Specimens are to be by trained medical or healthcare staff. Radiographers are one of the recruits assisting in specimen collection at community testing centres.

To recognize the registrants' effort in the fight against COVID-19, registered radiographers are allowed to apply for CPD points with 1 CPD point per hour and a maximum of 4 CPD points for the participation in the COVID-19 UCTP and the relevant training received beforehand. Registered radiographers are reminded to keep relevant supporting documents as evidence of participation (such as the appointment letter and log sheet).
