

FULL REGISTRATION UNDER ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS
ORDINANCE (Chapter 359)

It is hereby notified that in accordance with section 4(1) of the Physiotherapists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation, Chapter 359J, Laws of Hong Kong, the Supplementary Medical Professions Council ("the Council") specifies the following qualifications required for registration as a physiotherapist with full registration:—

- (1) a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physiotherapy or a Bachelor of Science (Honours) Degree in Physiotherapy awarded by the Hong Kong Polytechnic or The Hong Kong Polytechnic University;
- (2) a Professional Diploma in Physiotherapy issued by the Hong Kong Polytechnic on or before 1 January 1995;
- (3) a certificate issued by the Hong Kong Government School of Physiotherapy of the Medical and Health Department on or before 1 January 1981;
- (4) a Master Degree in Physiotherapy issued by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University;
- (5) a degree of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Physiotherapy issued by Tung Wah College;
- (6) a Bachelor of Science with Honours Degree in Physiotherapy issued by Hong Kong Metropolitan University;
- (7) a Bachelor of Science (Honours) Degree in Physiotherapy issued by Saint Francis University; or
- (8) a certificate from the Physiotherapists Board that he has passed an examination relating to physiotherapy conducted under section 15A of the Ordinance for the purposes of section 12(1)(a) of the Ordinance.

It is also hereby notified that in accordance with section 4(2) of the Physiotherapists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation, Chapter 359J, Laws of Hong Kong, the Council specifies the following qualification and experience required for registration as a physiotherapist with full registration to be entered in Part Ia or Part Ib of the register:—

The Secretary must enter the name of a physiotherapist:—

- (a) who:—
 - (i) holds a qualification referred as (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) or (8) of this Notice; and
 - (ii) has recognized experience of not less than 1 year acquired after the physiotherapist acquired such qualification,
in Part Ia of the register; and
- (b) who holds a qualification referred as (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) or (8) of this Notice but does not have the recognized experience referred to in (a)(ii) of this Notice, in Part Ib of the register.

Applications for full registration should be made in accordance with the guidelines published by the Physiotherapists Board and Council.
