

FULL REGISTRATION UNDER ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS
ORDINANCE (Chapter 359)

It is hereby notified that in accordance with section 6(1) of the Radiographers (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation, Chapter 359H, Laws of Hong Kong, the Supplementary Medical Professions Council ("the Council") specifies the following qualifications required for registration as a radiographer with full registration:—

- (1) a Bachelor of Science (Honours) degree in Radiography awarded by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University;
- (2) a Bachelor of Science degree in Radiography awarded by the Hong Kong Polytechnic or The Hong Kong Polytechnic University before 1 January 2002;
- (3) a Professional Diploma in Diagnostic Radiography issued by the Hong Kong Polytechnic or The Hong Kong Polytechnic University before 1 January 1997;
- (4) a degree of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Radiation Therapy awarded by Tung Wah College;
- (5) a degree of Bachelor of Medical Science (Honours) Major in Radiation Therapy awarded by Tung Wah College;
- (6) a Higher Certificate in Diagnostic Radiography issued by the Hong Kong Polytechnic or The Hong Kong Polytechnic University before 1 January 1996;
- (7) a Certificate in Diagnostic Radiography issued by the Hong Kong Polytechnic before 1 January 1991;
- (8) a Diploma issued by the Hong Kong Radiological Technicians Association before 1 January 1982; or
- (9) a certificate from the Radiographers Board ("the Board") that he has passed an examination conducted by it under section 15A of the Ordinance for the purposes of section 12(1)(a) of the Ordinance and relating to the profession of radiographers.

It is also hereby notified that in accordance with section 6(2) of the Radiographers (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation, Chapter 359H, Laws of Hong Kong, the Council specifies the following qualification and experience required for registration as a radiographer with full registration to be entered in Part I, Part II or Part III of the register:—

- (A) The name of a diagnostic radiographer who holds:—
 - (a) a qualification referred as (1), (2) or (3) of this Notice and, subject to item (B) of this Notice, has experience:—
 - (i) of not less than 2 years;
 - (ii) acquired after obtaining the qualification referred as (1), (2) or (3) of this Notice as may be applicable; and
 - (iii) recognized by the Board for the purposes of this specification; or
 - (b) a qualification referred as (6) of this Notice and, subject to item (B) of this Notice, has experience:—
 - (i) of not less than 10 years;
 - (ii) acquired after obtaining the qualification referred as (6), (7) or (8) of this Notice and at least 3 years of which shall have been acquired after obtaining the Higher Certificate in Diagnostic Radiography issued by the Hong Kong Polytechnic or The Hong Kong Polytechnic University referred as (6) of this Notice; and
 - (iii) which is recognized by the Board for the purposes of this specification,

and whose application for registration has been approved by the Board under section 13(2) of the Ordinance shall be entered by the Secretary in Part I (Category D) of the register.

- (B) In any particular case the Board may, subject to such conditions relating to acquisition of post-qualification experience as it may impose, accept as satisfying the requirement of experience in item (A)(a) or (b) of this Notice experience of such duration as it may determine acquired before the person becomes qualified for registration.

(C) The name of a diagnostic radiographer who holds a qualification referred as (1), (2) or (3) of this Notice but does not have the experience referred to in item (A)(a) of this Notice and whose application for registration has been approved by the Board under section 13(2) of the Ordinance shall be entered by the Secretary in Part II (Category D) of the register.

(D) The name of a diagnostic radiographer who holds:—

- the qualification referred as (6) of this Notice but does not have the experience referred to in section A(b);
- a Certificate in Diagnostic Radiography issued by the Hong Kong Polytechnic referred as (7) of this Notice;
- a Diploma issued by the Hong Kong Radiological Technicians Association referred as (8) of this Notice; or
- the qualification referred as (9) of this Notice,

and whose application for registration has been approved by the Board under section 13(2) of the Ordinance shall be entered by the Secretary in Part III (Category D) of the register.

(E) The name of a therapeutic radiographer who:—

- holds a qualification referred as (1), (2), (4) or (5) of this Notice and,
- has experience:—
 - of not less than 2 years;
 - acquired after obtaining the qualification referred as (1), (2), (4) or (5) of this Notice; and
 - recognized by the Board for the purposes of this specification,

shall be entered by the Secretary in Part I (Category T) of the register.

(F) The name of a therapeutic radiographer who holds a qualification referred to in item (E)(a) of this Notice but does not have the experience referred to in item (E)(b) of this Notice shall be entered by the Secretary in Part II (Category T) of the register.

It is also hereby notified that in accordance with section 6(3)(a) of the Radiographers (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation, Chapter 359H, Laws of Hong Kong, the Council specifies the following qualification for the purposes of section 7(2)(a)(i) of that Regulation:—

A qualification referred as (1), (2), (3), (6), (7), (8) or (9) of this Notice.

It is also hereby notified that in accordance with section 6(3)(b) of the Radiographers (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation, Chapter 359H, Laws of Hong Kong, the Council specifies the following qualification for the purposes of section 7(3)(a)(i) of that Regulation:—

A qualification referred as (1), (2), (4) or (5) of this Notice.

Applications for full registration should be made in accordance with the guidelines published by the Board and Council.
